In March 2021 Solids & Recycling-Technik Dortmund will be safe and future-oriented

(Dortmund) Against the background of uncertainty due to the coronavirus pandemic, Solids & Recycling-Technik will allow the industry to meet on 17 & 18 March 2021 in Dortmund under the protection of a robust safety concept. The show's motto, "Moving the industry together. In safety." expresses the organiser's promise to provide participants with an opportunity for personal exchanges on the industry's most pressing challenges. The numerous exhibitors and experts, which will include some new faces, will be a rich source of high-quality information and new ideas; the setting invites trade show visitors to network in a safe and relaxed atmosphere.

Summing up the changes planned for the next-edition industry meeting, Sandrina Schempp, Event Director for organiser Easyfairs, says, "Working within the current constraints, our number one

priority is to run the trade show in a controlled and safe environment that's still pleasant for everyone involved." With its new protection concept, 'The Safest Place to Meet,' the organiser strives to create in Dortmund the conditions necessary for industry representatives to once again participate in face-to-face exchanges around the latest trends and solutions. The concept is grounded in the German Coronavirus Protection Ordinance, and it will be adapted to meet the requirements in force by the time the trade shows start on 17 March 2021. Compliance with the defined measures will be monitored and enforced by SGS SA, a renowned international auditing group. Until the trade shows start, visitors and exhibitors can find out about the latest status of safety and hygiene standards on the show websites.

Networking in a secure environment

Solids and Recycling-Technik will once again be made available to trade show visitors – up close, yet with the necessary distance. Visitors and exhibitors alike benefit from the organiser's pioneering role in digitalisation: From online registration with your own printout to the digital lead generation system 'Touch & Collect', networking can take place completely contact-free. Even access to the show will be made safe. In the entrance area, markings on the floor will help people keep minimum distances. The distancing concept continues through to the lecture spaces of the Innovation and SolutionCenters, where attendees will benefit from spacious seating arrangements – so they can concentrate on the presentations and discussions with experts. Additional room in the networking areas, as well as protective screens, will allow participants to meet and exchange ideas in person. The concept is rounded off by appropriate cleaning, hygiene, and other safety measures including hand sanitizing stations and, if required, free face masks.

Exhibitors emphasize the need for in-person contacts

Trade show visitors can look forward to seeing even more exhibitors on 17 & 18 March 2021. Since the postponement of the deadline, 13 additional companies have registered for Solids & Recycling-Technik. "These new participants confirm the industries' need to meet in person again after a long break," is how Sandrina Schempp explains the increase in exhibitors. For example, Meinert GmbH and Schüttfließ GmbH will exhibit for the first time at the industry get-together. A new premium partner, Roskopf Maschinen- und Metalltechnik GmbH, has also joined. For new bookings by 30 September 2020, Easyfairs is offering a preferential price to exhibit.
